Les Nuits de Fourvière is a multidisciplinary cultural festival (theater, music, dance, cinema, circus) held every summer (June, July and August) since 1946 at the Théâtre Antique de Fourvière (2,600 to 4,500 seats), in Lyon's 5th arrondissement, near the basilica of the same name.

It's a unique outdoor setting with a large and imposing ancient theater.

Programme opens on 7 March, tickets are usually selling fast, so don't delay in booking them!

Musée des Confluences, Lyon

Paul Bocuse, the chef of the century

Paul Bocuse, a symbol of French culinary excellence, pioneered Nouvelle Cuisine and founded the prestigious Bocuse d'Or competition. Recognised as the Cook of the Century by Gault et Millau in 1989 and Chef of the Century by the Culinary Institute of America in 2011, his influence transcended borders. Born in 1926 into a family of chefs near Lyon, he honed his skills under renowned mentors before achieving legendary status at L'Auberge du Pont de Collonges.

Remaining loyal to the restaurant throughout his life, Bocuse became synonymous with French culinary tradition, earning prestigious accolades. His embrace of 'nouvelle cuisine' revolutionized fine dining with simplicity and elegance, inspiring chefs globally. His iconic dishes, like the 'Black Truffle Soup VGE', continue to inspire.

Beyond his culinary innovations, Bocuse's greatest contribution was nurturing talent. He established the Institut Paul Bocuse in 1990 and founded the Bocuse d'Or competition in 1987, dedicated to shaping the future of culinary excellence. During the dinner, guests will experience his culinary heritage, balancing high quality with the Bocuse tradition.
